## Riddle

**Question:** During Chanukah this year, we will say one particular tefillah the most times it can possibly be said during Chanukah. What is the tefilla and how many times will we say it? (Note: This occurs in 18.4% of all years)

Last Week's Riddle:

**Question:** Many of us know of the Inbal Hotel in Yerushalayim. Did you know that the word "inbal" (spelled with an "ayin") is an Aramaic word (noun) in the Gemara and is related to the laws of Shabbat? What does "inbal" mean and what does it have to do with Shabbat?

**Answer:** "Inbal" is the clapper of a bell, and the Gemara in Shabbat 58b discusses whether it is permitted for a Jew to allow his animal to wear a bell with a clapper outdoors on Shabbat.
