## Riddle

**Question:** The Gemara says that when it comes to the four cups of wine for the Seder and the candles for Chanukah, even an indigent person must beg if necessary to obtain those objects to perform the Mitzvah. What do the four cups of wine and nerot Chanukah have in common that engenders that requirement?

Last Week's Riddle:

**Question:** During Chanukah this year, we will say one particular tefillah the most times it can possibly be said during Chanukah. What is the tefilla and how many times will we say it? (Note: This occurs in 18.4% of all years)

**Answer:** Because there are two Shabbatot and two days of Rosh Chodesh (not on Shabbat) during Chanukah this year, we will say Musaf four times.
