## Riddle

**Question:** Many Poskim mention a specific bracha that one should recite before giving his/her life as a Jewish martyr, rachmana litzlan. This bracha is almost identical to one we say in our tefillot every single day of the year. Do you know what it is??

Last Week's Riddle:

**Question:** We all know that fasting is Halachically sanctioned on Shabbat for Yom Kippur. Can you identify two other instances in which it is Halachically permitted to fast on Shabbat?

**Answer:** Rav Yosef in Shabbat 11a says that one should fast on Shabbat for a bad dream (taanit chalom), but one has to fast another day to atone for missing the Shabbat meals. A second example is one who is sick and cannot eat. That person's oneg Shabbat is NOT eating, rather than eating.
