Question: The last two verses of Tanach (Divrei HaYamim II 36:22-23) are identical (up to the last 8 words in verse 23) to the first two verses in another book of Tanach. Which book??

Last Week's Riddle:

Question: Many Poskim mention a specific bracha that one should recite before giving his/her life as a Jewish martyr, rachmana litzlan. This bracha is almost identical to one we say in our tefillot every single day of the year. Do you know what it is?

Answer: The bracha is "Mekadesh et shimcha ba'rabim" which we say in the korbanot section of Shacharit.
