### Riddle

**Question:** Some Rishonim hold that Ha Lachma Anya is the beginning of the Maggid portion of the Seder. Others say that Ma Nishtana is the start of Maggid. According to those in the latter group, what section of the Seder does Ha Lachma Anya belong to, and what is its purpose?

Last Week's Riddle:

**Question:** Lipmann Lipkin (d. 1875), while a mathematics graduate student in St. Petersburg, invented a linkage to convert circular motion into precise straight line motion. This device was used extensively in the design of engines and other mechanical devices for decades. Who was Lipkin's famous Rabbinical father?

**Answer:** R. Yisrael Salanter (1810-1883). Although the family name was Lipkin, he is known by the town he lived in (Salant or Salaty).
