Last Week's Riddle:

**Question:** There is a positive Rabbinic mitzvah to light candles on the eve of every Yom Kadosh (defined as a day of issur melacha, such as Shabbat and Yom Tov). However, there is one Yom Kadosh for which we light candles with a bracha as a minhag and not a mitzvah. Do you know which one?

**Answer:** Yom Kippur. See Orach Chaim 610:1.
