Riddle

Question: The Gemara applies R. Yehoshua ben Levi's dictum of "af hen hayu b'oto hanes" to obligate women in the observance of three Rabbinic commandments: lighting Chanuka candles, hearing the Megillah on Purim, and drinking four cups of wine at the Seder. Mishna Berura suggests using the dictum to obligate women in the performance of a particular Biblical commandment. Do you know which one?

Last Week's Riddle:

Question: Which of the following widespread customs originated in the past 3-5 centuries? (More than one may be true) (1) Wrapping the Tefillin strap around the forearm 7 times; (2) Saying the "Yehi Ratzon" prayer at the beginning of Rosh Chodesh benching; (3) Removing the Tefillin before Musaf on Rosh Chodesh and Chol HaMoed.?

Answer: All three of the above customs originated after the time of the Rishonim (i.e., in the past five hundred years).
