Last Week's Riddle:

**Question:** There are several explanations as to why we don't make a Birchah She'hechyanu on the counting of the Omer. But some Rishonim suggest that we actually do make that bracha on the Omer. What do you think they are referring to?

**Answer:** The She'hechyanu that we make on Shavuos, according to those Rishonim, also applies to the Omer. Since Shavuos has no fixed date in the Torah but rather occurs fifty days after the first day of Pesach, the Omer count actually establishes the date of Shavuos and that is signified by the She'hechyanu.
