Riddle

Question: "Shmoneh Esreh" is a misnomer since there are 19 blessings in our amidah. According to Midrash Rabbah (Parshat Korach, Chap. 18), "velamalshinin" was NOT the last bracha inserted into the amidah, but rather was the 18th. Do you what bracha according to the Midrash was the 19th?

Last Week's Riddle:

Question: We are soon about to complete the Mitzvah of counting the days of the Omer (d'Rabbanan according to most Poskim today). A number of Rishonim cite two other counting Mitzvot in the Torah. Do you know what they are?

Answer: The Mitzvah for the Sanhedrin to count the years of the Yovel cycle, and the Mitzva for a woman to count seven clean days (we paskin that she only needs to calculate the seven days, not actually count them).
