Riddle

Question: We intentionally wear a four-cornered garment to fulfill the mitzvah of Tzitzit. But since we don't have techeilet, why aren't we performing the mitzvah in a deficient way which would violate the commandment of "bal tigrā", not to detract from mitzvot?

Last Week's Riddle:

Question: According to the Gemara in the second chapter of Kiddushin (40-41), the action of a person's agent (shlich) is exactly the same as if the person did it himself (shlucho shel adam k'moto). Why then can't one appoint an agent to put on Tefillin every day for him?

Answer: One answer to this question is offered by Ketot HaChoshen in Choshen Mishpat 182:2. He says that shlichut only applies to an action (ma'aseh), but a Mitzva such as Tefillin requires a kiyum (fulfillment) of wearing Tefillin. So appointing someone else to put on Tefillin on himself is equivalent to the appointer (m'shaleach) putting Tefillin on the shaliach (agent), so of course the m'shaleach has not fulfilled his own obligation to wear Tefillin.
