**Question:** There are four synonyms for "human being" in the Hebrew language: gever, ish, enosh and adam. Three have plural forms and one does not. Which one does not, and what is the significance of that?

**Answer:** Plurals for the first three are "g'varim," "ishim" and "anashim." "Adam" only has a singular form. According to Yevamot 61a, only Jews are termed "adam" because of the covenantal bond that unifies all of us as one.
