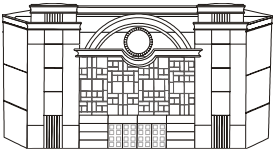

I hope this letter finds you well. As we prepare for the Yomin Noraim 5771, we are pleased to announce our plans for the shul.

We will be davening with two minyanim, both at night and during the day. One minyan will be in the Main Shul and another minyan in the Beis Medrash.

As there is limited seating, only reservations from members (including requests for the same seats) will be accepted prior to August 1. After that, seating will be on a first come-first served basis. Given our shuls history, we are unable to guarantee seating will be available. **NO** reservations will be accepted without payment.

Please note the change in pricing structure this year. For reservations received after August 1, seat prices will increase

Members:

By August 1, the cost per seat: \$125.

After August 1, the cost per seat: \$150

Non-Members:

All seats are \$200.

In order to buy seats at the member rate, all financial obligations to the shul must be addressed. For special arrangements, please contact Yitzchak Handel.

The cost for babysitting will be \$54 per family. As in past years, babysitting will be provided for children ages 3-9. To ensure proper supervision while at shul, we are requiring parents to register their children for the youth program prior to Yom Tov. Please fill out the enclosed form if you will be utilizing this service. Parents will also be required to both "check in" and "check out" their children over Yom Tov. We welcome and encourage parents to purchase seats for their children and have them sit in shul with their families for as long as they can. We respectfully request that parents make responsible arrangements for their children for when they can, understandably, no longer sit in shul. No child will be allowed to roam the halls of the shul.

If anyone has any questions or comments feel free to contact me. We look forward to a meaningful and enjoyable Yom Tov. Have a wonderful summer and Ksiva V'chasima Tovah.
